

Dear Students,

The earthquake disaster we experienced has profoundly affected us, many families, and you, our students, I remember our lost students with love and wish everyone patience with my condolences. As the faculty, we tried and will do our best to reach each and every one of you at every moment of the earthquake. We realize once again that we are a country of earthquakes and there is a need for more understanding, unity, and solidarity these days. Just as we will not abandon our students who were damaged in the earthquake, we can never ignore our less-affected students. In this sense, after the last earthquake disaster and the difficult days, we experienced, it was necessary to specify the following issues regarding how education is to be held in our Faculty and how education will continue.

1- On 20 February 2023, evaluation of education and course selections, add/drop processes will begin,

2- To be valid until the week of 3 April 2023:

- a. All theoretical courses in the Faculty of Pharmacy will be online and held with distance education opportunities,
- b. The 5th-grade project course will be held face-to-face, but students who cannot attend will carry out their projects by using distance education opportunities in communication with their advisors,
- c. Except for Internship-1, all internships will continue and will be done face-to-face,
- d. Practical lessons will be held with distance education opportunities, but students who want to come to the school and practice will be given a chance to do these practical studies in a separate program every week,
- e. The consultancy and all scientific activities, projects, and such activities will be carried out face to face with the students who can come, and those who cannot attend these activities will be provided with the opportunity to participate in these activities with distance education opportunities,

3- The doors of our faculty are always open to all our students, face-to-face to our students who can come; All services related to their needs will continue to be provided to those who cannot attend, with remote access opportunities,

4- As stated above, all issues are valid until the week of 3-April-2023, and a re-evaluation will be made according to the instructions of our YÖK and University Rectorate and you will be informed about how to proceed.
